


- Crystal Falls: (7 minutes) 4.5 miles on Highway US2

on this mile long trail!




- Crystal Falls: (13 minutes) 9.6 miles on Highway 69

- Park closes at 10 P.M.




- Crystal Falls: (33 minutes) 24 miles on Highway 141
